Justin received a bachelor's degree in Music Education and graduated with honors from Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina. He is currently pursuing a master's degree in Sacred Music from Concordia University. He is a member of the Music Educators National Conference (MENC), the Fellowship of United Methodist Musicians and Worship Arts (FUMMWA), and the Savannah Chapter of the American Guild of Organists (AGO).
