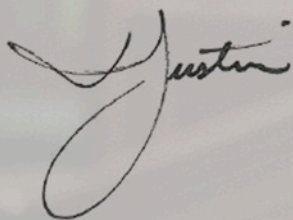
It is with great joy that I present to you the 2013-2014 Music & Worship Series of Skidaway Island United Methodist Church.

In the pages that follow, you will discover a myriad of programs that display our congregation's commitment to presenting quality music and worship to our Creator.

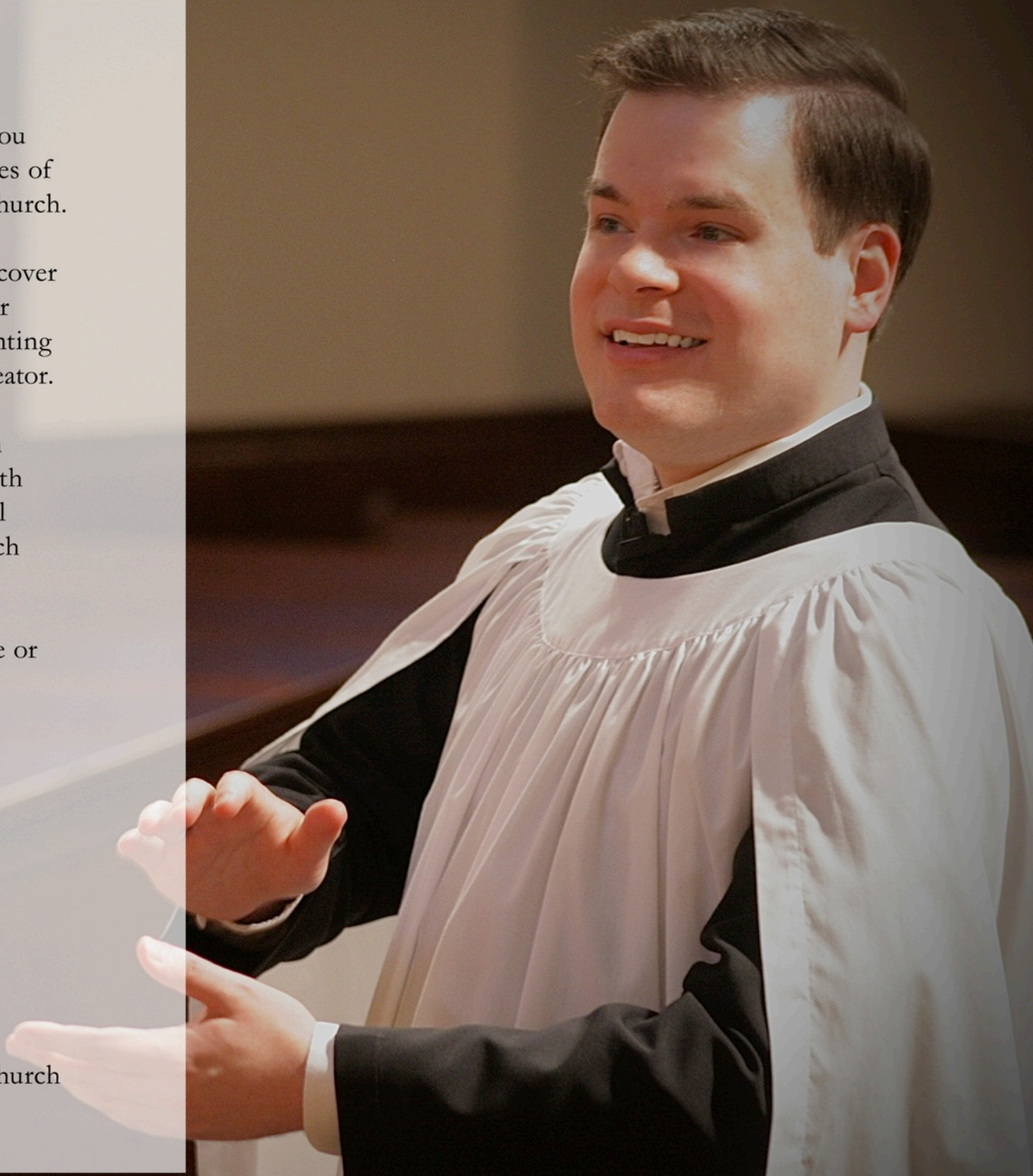
It is our hope that this year's Arts on Skidaway Concert Series, together with our Sanctuary and Chapel Series, will serve the growing needs of our church and our community.
