ABOUT THE ARTIST

Justin L. Addington has served as Director of Music and Worship for Skidaway Island United Methodist Church since June of 2010. At SIUMC, Justin conducts the Chancel Choir, two adult handbell groups, and one of three Children's Choirs. In addition to these duties, he serves as organist, manages the church's active concert series, and coordinates all aspects of worship. During his time at SIUMC, Justin has overseen the design and installation of a new 89 rank organ, led the Chancel Choir on concert tours to Italy and NYC, and worked to establish the church's reputation for excellence in the areas of music and worship. Prior to coming to Savannah, Justin lived in Spartanburg, South Carolina, where he taught music in the public schools, and worked as a musical director for community and professional theatres. Justin received a bachelor's degree in Music Education and graduated with honors from Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina. In 2012 he was honored as the college's Young Alumnus of the Year. He recently completed a master of Church Music degree with an emphasis in choral conducting from Concordia University Wisconsin. Justin is a member of the Fellowship of United Methodist Musicians, The Hymn Society, The American Guild of Handbell Ringers, and is immediate past Dean of the Savannah Chapter of the American Guild of Organists. Justin recently celebrated his thirtieth birthday, which marks his fifteenth year as a church musician.

ABOUT THE ORGAN

The **Schantz Organ Company** from Orrville, Ohio, completed the installation of a new 56-rank pipe organ at St. Peter's in September of 2003. Eleven ranks sing from an antiphonal division over the west door; the remainder are housed in a magnificent mahogany case at the east end. The organ was dedicated at a service of Evensong on October 12th, followed by a recital by Indianapolis organist Dale Caldwell
